COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

The following changes have made to our Covid worship unlock plan:

- The wearing of face coverings is optional at all times inside, including at all points of our services.
- Communion is offered in both kinds (bread and wine). It is important that no one feels any pressure to receive in both kinds if they prefer to continue to receive in one kind (bread) only.
- Intinction (dipping the wafer into the wine) is not permitted.

Whilst restrictions are relaxed further, please do continue to respect each other's preferences, especially those who may be, or feel, particularly vulnerable.
