

# **Welcome to our May Parish News**

As I write this, all the celebrations for King Charles III's coronation are all coming to an end. No matter what the weather, the whole weekend seems to have lifted many people's spirits as they have taken part in many, often community, celebrations. There has been the spectacle of the coronation itself, the street parties, decorations, and family get togethers to celebrate the occasion, usually with far too much food. And now the bunting and balloons have to come down and life goes back to normal again. It feels a bit like this once Christmas is over and the decorations and displays are packed away.

Within our Church year, when you read this, we will have also had Easter, Ascension and Pentecost celebrations within our Church in relatively quick succession - celebrating the wonder and love of God for us through Jesus and the gift of his Holy Spirit to help us as we live out our commitment as Christians to be his Body in the world.

And now, the church too, seems to have a quiet time approaching which we call 'Ordinary Time.' What is this ordinary time? It is the longest season in the Church's year. It lasts for 33 weeks in two sections. The first section is a short one from the Christmas season to the beginning of Lent. The second is from Pentecost until the beginning of Advent. The meaning of the word ordinary may also be different to what you think. 'Ordinary' in this context, comes from the word 'ordinal' meaning 'counted'. All the weeks are known by a number.

It is during this time that our attention is turned to Jesus' ministry and teaching. As we learn and reflect from what we hear in our gospel readings, it becomes a time to think about how we can reflect the person and work of Jesus in our ordinary everyday lives. In this way, life becomes anything but ordinary as we experience the challenge and joy of serving and following Christ in all times.

#### **Morecambe Bay Partnership**

I wanted to get in touch, on behalf of local charity <u>Morecambe Bay Partnership</u>, to let you know about a creative/walking/environmental project called 'Bay Lines: Beach of Dreams' happening this summer around the Bay. We're really keen to invite all the Bay's coastal parishes/communities to take part and I wondered if you might be kind enough to share the invitation with anyone you feel might be interested.

We have teamed up with an arts organization called Kinetika and local production company Rosa Productions to deliver Beach of Dreams. (Beach of Dreams is going to be a national initiative in 2025 and we have commissioned a special version of it for Morecambe Bay this year.)

It's all about promoting opportunities for walking, sharing conversations and creativity, around the Morecambe Bay coast. Together, we've mapped the Bay coastline into 120 miles of walkable route from Fleetwood to Barrow. Kinetika's artistic director, Ali Pretty, is walking the whole route from 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> June and she's interested in speaking with artists, writers, scientists, coastal engineers, nature experts, campaigners, landowners and local people—anyone with a connection to the coast—along the way. She wants to explore environmental conversations and get people thinking about what the future of our coast might look like.

We're also inviting local people to sign up to a mile that means something to them, to walk it (in their own time), photograph something of interest and share it with the project. These stories will then be translated into beautiful silk pennant flags to be installed around the Bay over the August bank holiday.







# How to be Greener - Make your garden more drought-resistant

The following tips will help make your garden more resistant to drought conditions:

**Cultivate** the soil deeply and dig in large quantities of organic matter to improve soil structure, soil water retention and water availability for plants. Well-rotted garden compost, mushroom compost, composted bark and well-rotted farmyard manure are all suitable forms of organic matter.

**Apply sufficient fertiliser** as plants use water most efficiently where nutrient levels are adequate. But do not apply too much fertiliser to the soil, as this can encourage too much lush growth which can flop in summer, require extra watering, and become frost damaged in winter.

Choose plants with grey-green or silver leaves as they reflect the sun's rays, helping to conserve moisture within the plant tissues.

**Try to choose plants which suit the site's** soil type and aspect. They will be more tolerant of varying climatic conditions as well as of pest and disease problems.

**Plant things while they are still small**. They will develop much greater resilience as they adapt to their conditions from a young age. Ideally plant in autumn so they can do some growing before dry weather arrives.

If planting Mediterranean plants, do so in spring when the soil is warming up. Many of these plants will suffer from root-rot if planted in autumn and become cold and damp over winter.

**Before planting,** thoroughly soak the plants in their pots in a bucket of water until the bubbles stop rising to the surface.

**Thoroughly water in** all new plants (and keep them watered in the first season after planting to ensure they establish well). Once established, they will become much more drought-tolerant.

**After planting,** mulch the bed with 5-7.5cm (2-3in) of gravel or, even better, a layer of compost or straw covered with gravel, to help retain moisture while the plants establish.

**Consider making a gravel garden**. These are low maintenance and are a good option if you already have sandy or gravelly soil.

**Remove weeds** regularly to prevent them depriving your plants of water.

You may decide to do without a lawn in your drought-friendly garden, but if you cannot do without this feature in your garden, then you may be pleased to know that lawns are surprisingly drought tolerant, and usually recover well in the autumn rains, even if they have been brown and parched most of the summer. Lawn irrigation should rarely be required, if at all, to keep the grass healthy.
