In the vacancy, a substantially reduced parish share was agreed with the Diocese. Now that Alice is our Vicar, we need to provide the resource to pay her stipend and other associated costs. There is a significant gap between current giving and what we need to receive to sustain ministry so we inviting everyone to review their current giving during June and consider increasing it. The gap equates to almost £35k – which works out as an additional £10/week per regular giver, less if we have new congregation members giving as well. Alice and the Treasurers are very happy to answer questions about this.
