St Oswald's 50/50 Club Rules

1. The Club is run by St. Oswald's PCC who delegate the running to individuals, the organisers.
2. Participation cost to members will be £52/year per entry.
3. Payment for membership must be made in advance by either cheque or Standing Order.
4. Members may purchase one or more entries.
5. Members will be allocated one number per entry, which will serve as a chance in each draw.
6. Only members who have paid by the 15th of a month will be included in the draw for that month.
7. Prize money may be changed monthly depending upon the number of entrants for that month.
8. Winners will be announced on the last Sunday of each month after church.
9. An extra draw will be made at Christmas to ensure that 50% of the receipts are paid out in prize money. This draw will be for the surplus in the prize fund that has accumulated to date.
10. Prizes will be paid out by cheque and either hand delivered or posted.
11. 50% of the draw receipts will comprise the prize fund and 50% will support the Church funds.
12. The minimum membership period is 1 year.
13. The minimum age of entry is 18 years.
14. Monthly winners will be announced in the weekly notices sheet and published on the church website: www.ubwby.org/warton
15. The organisers will be responsible for the correct termination of the 50/50 Club.
16. The Club will not commence operating until it has a minimum of 30 entries. Cheques will not be presented to the bank until this has been achieved. Members will then be informed of the starting date of the Club.
17. The first draw will be on 26th January 2025. In the unlikely event that we don't get 30 members by 31st January 2025, the club will not be created, and Standing Orders and cheques will be returned to the potential members.
18. A copy of the Rules, the allocation of Prize Money and the names of Prize Winners will be on display in St. Oswald's Church.
19. The organisers' decisions are final.
20. To enter, complete the slip above and return it, with payment to the box at the back of church.
